Useful information on how to act in case of flooding

Please read everything with attention to detail and inform your friends, family and neighbors.



How to act when a flooding occurs

- if you are safe, stay at home;
- avoid relocating to affected areas;

if you live in an area of high risk, evacuate your area following alerts and guidance from your local authorities;

when evacuating, shut off the main circuit of electricity and gas and water valves;

If you are alone in a high-risk area, contact Firefighters immediately at 193:



Precautions when returning home post-flooding

before returning home, verify the safety conditions of your home's electricity and infrastructure;

post-flooding, sanitize your entire home and objects that had contact with water;

clean your house with bleach, using 1 liter of bleach for every 20 liters of water;

clean and disinfect your home's water bow with 2.5% sodium hypochlorite or bleach;



Precautions when returning home post-flooding

people working to remove mud and debris must protect themselves by using rain boots and rubber gloves to avoid one's skin contacting contaminated water or mud (if not possible, use double plastic bags wrapped around feet and hands). also use tissue or a rag to cover nose and mouth;

prevent **leptospirosis** by avoiding direct skin contact with water and mud from floods or sewage as much as possible;



Precautions when returning home post-flooding

direct contact with rubble or debris can cause skin injuries and, consequently, **tetanus illness**. do not walk barefoot, reduce the risk of injury by wearing **rain boots or rigid shoes** with protection up to knees and long pants;

after the flood period, venomous animals seek shelter in dry places, it is important to be aware of the presence of these animals to avoid the risk of accidents;



Who to reach out for help

if you need rescue or assistance during floods, it is important to know who to turn to for quick and effective help. Keep emergency numbers close at hand.
